Your admission fee is refundable if you are admitted to other universities!

- ◆ It's **hard** to be admitted **as a 3rd year transfer student** to other universities in Japan. Why is it so?

TUSW Group offers you opportunities to study in Japan with large capacity of transfer students!

Transferring to 3rd grade in most other universities in Japan:

- Small capacity for transfer students
- Difficult entrance exam in Japanese
- You will be pressured to enter as freshman even if you have a Bachelor's degree from a university in your home country.

Transferring to 3rd grade in TUSW:

- Transfer students are widely welcome.
- Entrance exam to evaluate your academic potential, not only your knowledge of Japanese language.
- Your academic degrees and credits from universities abroad will be rightfully accepted.

- ◆ **You can earn the Degree of Bachelor of Arts (BA) upon graduation!**

We adopt Dual Enrollment Program in which you are enrolled in both the TUSW Correspondence Program and its affiliated vocational college at the same time.

- ◆ **We are adopting Internal Recommendation System (Planning);**

Students have chances to obtain a Recommendation Certificate for MA Graduate Schools upon admission.

Affiliated College Program:

College of Government Officer, Child Welfare, Care Work & Business (the sister school of TUSW)
—You can learn advanced elderly welfare and preschool education in Japan, and gain a bachelor's degree in Social Welfare and Child Studies.—

You will earn BA (Bachelor of Arts) through this dual enrollment program where students are enrolled in the Correspondence Program of TUSW as well as its affiliated college (a four-year program of International Business and Information).

Students will earn the Bachelor's Degree from a highly rated program with a unique method of education, and excellent professors and curriculum.

- **Japanese Interpretation Course • Business Management & Social Welfare Course, Division of International Business and Information (A four-year program) (3rd year transfer students will study for 2 years)**

◆ **You can apply to more than one school!!**

You can also apply to other national, public, and private universities as well as graduate schools (including research students programs) without worrying about admission fees!

Our system:

- Once you pass our entrance exam, you can secure TUSW's pass certificate only by paying admission fee.
- If you pass an entrance exam of another university and you wish to enter it, the admission fee you had paid to us will be refunded to you.

Students who apply to TUSW, pass the entrance exam, and wish to apply to other universities or graduate schools as well (including research students programs) will have to **pay to us only the admission fee**. You can postpone the payment of **other tuitions and fees until the day when you will be notified the result of the entrance exams of other schools you applied to**. If you decide to enter another school, **the entire admission fee you paid to us will be returned to you**. If you decide to enter TUSW, you will only have to pay the rest of the fees excluding the admission fee.

Currently Accepting Applications!!

There is a higher chance of acceptance and higher pass rate if you **apply earlier!**

● **Students applying from the designated schools will get benefit including exemption of tuition!**

Students who apply with the recommendation from the schools designated by TUSW will be exempt of the admission fee of this vocational college (100,000 yen) as scholarship. Furthermore, students who pay the tuition and fees as a lump sum will be exempt of additional 50,000 yen from the total fee.

※After entering TUSW, students whose attendance rate and academic performance are good, can receive a scholarship which is decided stepwise from the maximum amount of exemption.

<Tuition and Fees for the first year>

The average amount of tuition of Schools of Child Care and Social Welfare of other Japanese universities is approximately 1,300,000 yen. The tuition of TUSW School of Business Administration is considerably lower than others. Moreover, if you pay the fee in a lump sum, you can save 50,000 yen.

◆ **Faculty research students and postgraduate research students (Application with the recommendation from the designated schools)**

The credits obtained as a research student can be included in the number of credits required to graduate from the TUSW regular program after you are admitted to the third year of the regular program as transfer student or admitted to the graduate school as regular student.

The Research Students Program of TUSW is intended for those who wish to study education/ social welfare/ child care and early childhood education/ and psychology at TUSW, and wish to obtain knowledge in Japanese culture and proficiency in Japanese language necessary for studying in the above-mentioned fields. (The preliminary program preparing students to transfer to the third academic year or Master's program of TUSW Graduate School)

Faculty Research Students

Students who apply with the recommendation from the schools designated by TUSW will be exempt of the admission fee (100,000 yen) as a scholarship grant. Furthermore, students who pay the tuition and fees as a lump will be exempt of additional 30,000 yen from the total fee.
